

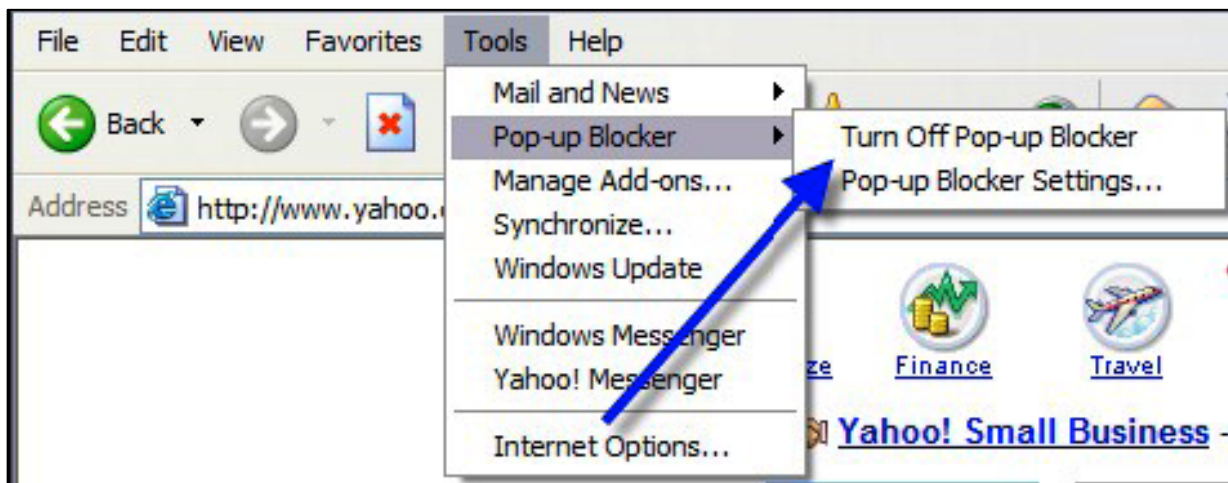
INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISABLING POP-UP BLOCKERS

Internet Explorer

- When you install SP2, Pop-up Blocker is turned on in Internet Explorer and set to the medium setting, which means it will block most automatic pop-ups.
- The default settings for the pop-up blocker allow you to see pop-ups that are opened when you click a link or button on a Web site.
- Pop-up Blocker will also play a sound and show the Information Bar when a pop-up is blocked.
- You can adjust these settings so that Pop-up Blocker works the way you want it to.

To Turn-off Pop-up Blocker

1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. On the **Tools** menu, point to **Pop-up Blocker**, and then click **Turn-off Pop-up Blocker**.
